7. Process:-

- (a) Brief process of manufacture

The components that give Beer its form are well established for their nutritive Value-barley malt, cane sugar, crystal clear water and aromatic flowers (Hops). Malt is the principal brewing material that provides carbohydrates. Carbohydrates are the source of raw material for alcohol and nitrogen compounds which contribute to Beer's flavor. The processes of malting barley used for brewing purposes are steeping, Germination and kilning. Hops are significant as they contain the bitter compounds (Humulones), which give Beer its characteristic bitter taste. Certain preservative helps this natural process. Even the alcohol in Beer evolves naturally from the starch and sugar in the raw Ingredient and the stable that brings the best out of Beer. This is the process that goes into making Beer. The product called Wort is separated from the used grain and poured into fermentation tanks where yeast is added. After fermentation is completed, Beer is transferred into separate tanks- called lager tanks, for maturation. After maturation beer is filtered and that's when the Beer is ready to be bottled and served.
